There will be a "teaching table" with animal skins, skulls, teeth, claws for teaching and explanations of their uses.

There will be a flute player and story teller.

Come take a step back in time to the 1700's in CONOYTOWN. Play a game or two, watch an arrow head take shape, listen to an ancient story about how fire came to earth.
